User Guide

How to configure the extension.

1. Configure the extension.

For installation kindly refer the installation manual.

Once installed kindly browse to, Admin > Stores > Configuration (Settings) > DecryptWeb Extensions > DW Notification Mail, below mentioned options will be as seen as in Pic #1,

NotificationMail Configuration

- **Enable Notification Mail:** Turn the notification on or off. If set to 'No,' no emails will be sent when a new customer registers on the store.

The default value is set to 'No' when installed.

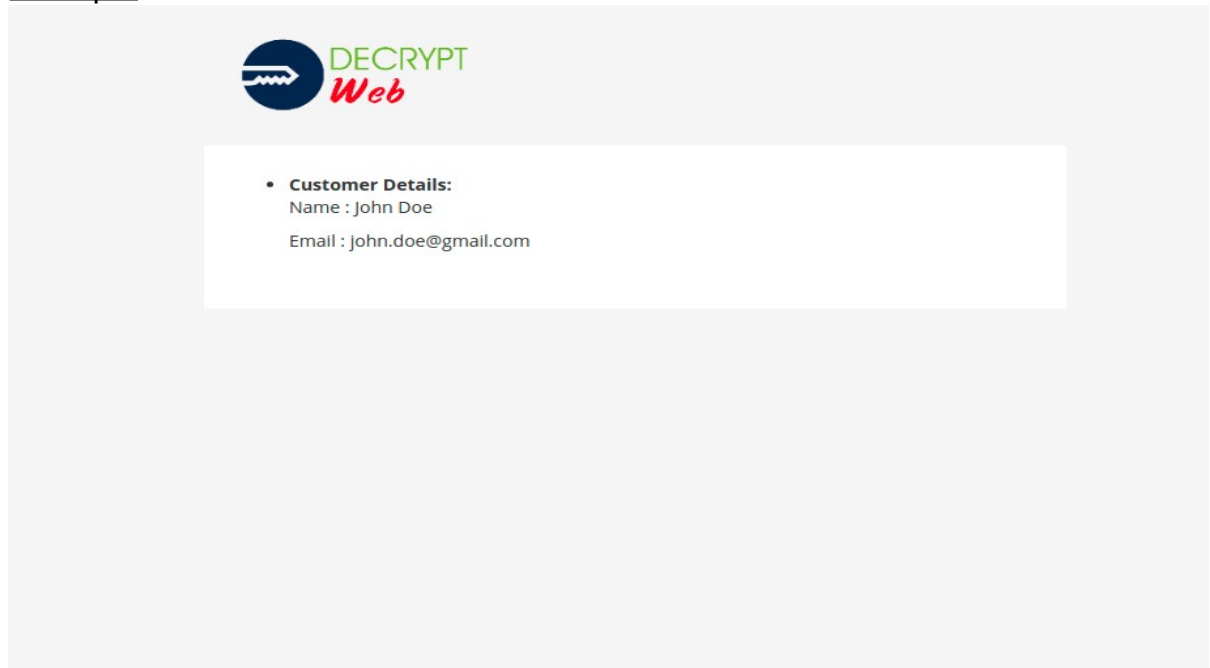
Option Yes For example as seen in the Pic #1 above, If the option is set to 'Yes', if customer registers on the store, a notification mail will be triggered.

Option No If the option is set to 'No', notification mail will not be sent.

- **Notification Email Template:** Select the default template or create a new template and choose the newly created template for the new customer registration email.

The default value is set to 'New Customer Registration Notification (Default)' template when installed.

Option Default For example as seen in the Pic #1 above, If the option is set to default, on customer registration, the recipient will receive this default mail as seen in Pic#2.

- **Notification Email Sender:** Select the sender that will be used as the sender address in the notification email.

Example : As seen in Pic #1 above, General Contact is set as the sender, so the email address specified in Admin > Stores > Configuration (Settings) > General > Store Email Addresses for General will be used

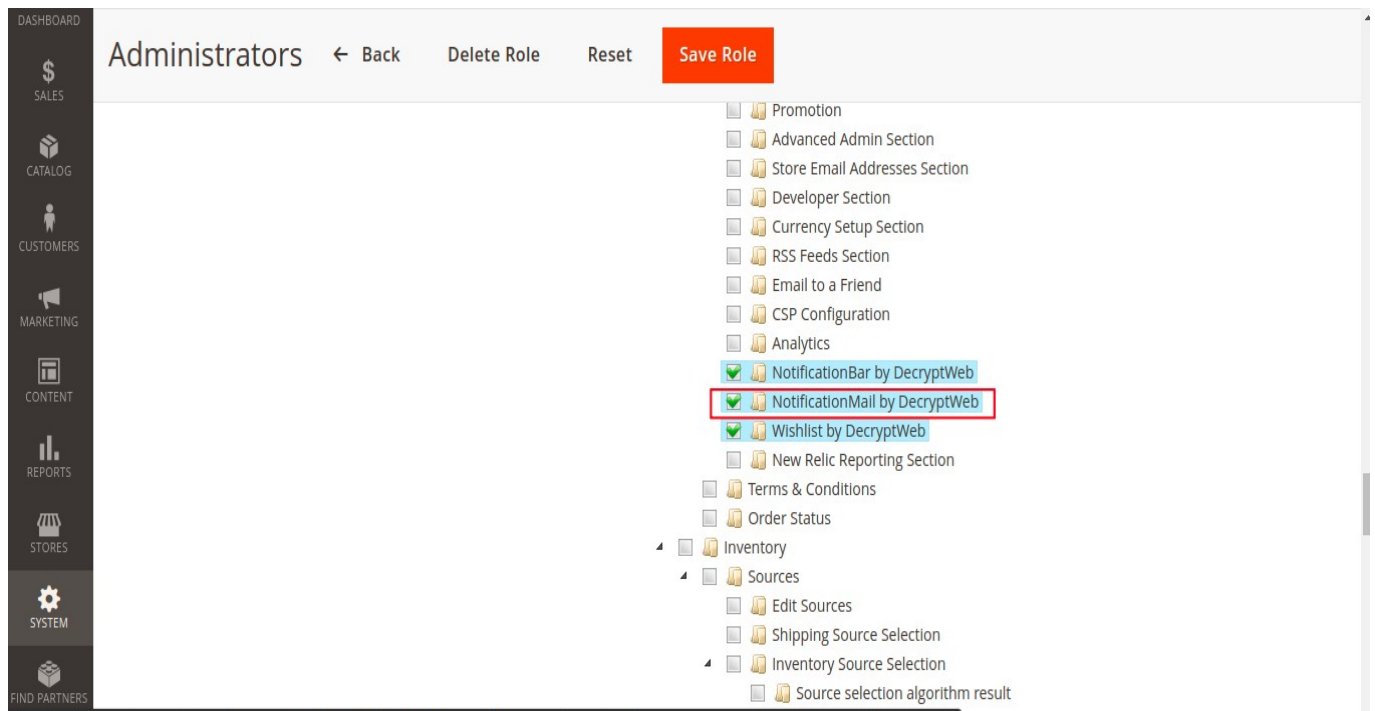
- **Notification Email Recipient:** Specify the email address where the notification will be sent, ensuring that the right person or team is alerted of new registrations.

The default value is set to empty when installed.

Example : For example as seen in the Pic #1 above, the recipient email is set, on customer registration a mail will be sent to this email address.

2. ACL Configuration

ACL configuration can be found under User Role, under Configuration > NotificationMail by DecryptWeb as seen in the pic below,
